#### **Curate**

There is a vacancy for a priest, ordained in the Church of England and licenced by the Diocese in Europe with experience of the liberal catholic tradition, to complete their curacy, assisting the incumbent in the full range of priestly ministry to the anglophone community in this growing city-centre Anglican church.

Responsibilities will include presiding and preaching at the Eucharist and other services; leading and working with families for baptisms, marriages and funerals; pastoral care; young people's ministry, including preparation for Confirmation and first Communion; involvement in the church's charitable outreach programme; acting as the church's liaison between the Anglican Communion Office and the UN agencies.

Successful candidates will:

- Be an ordained priest in the Church of England
- Have at least two years' experience in assisting with leadership in parish ministry, including a period serving in a church in the Diocese in Europe.
- A degree in theology.
- Formal training in Church of England canon and liturgy and broader Anglicanism, combined with a knowledge and understanding of other Christian denominations and other faiths.
- Proven experience of advocacy, communications and public relations
- English mother tongue or equivalent

In line with the Diocese in Europe policy we welcome applications from all qualified candidates, including women and those of multi-ethnic origin.

Employment is dependent on obtaining the necessary work and residence permits, which for non Swiss or EU nationals includes a requirement to pass the relevant French language qualifications.
